

SENATE MOTION

MR. PRESIDENT:

I move that Engrossed House Bill 1050 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Delete everything after the enacting clause and insert the following:
2 "SECTION 1. IC 20-10.1-4.1-5 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
3 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1999]: Sec. 5. (a) The state task
4 force is established to review and recommend to the state board for the
5 state board's approval the following:
6 (1) The educational proficiency standards described in IC
7 20-10.1-16-6.
8 (2) The content and format of the ISTEP testing program, including the
9 ~~graduation examination, under IC 20-10.1-16,~~ and the passing scores
10 required at various grade levels.
11 SECTION 2. IC 20-10.1-16-8 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
12 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1999]: Sec. 8. (a) The state
13 superintendent shall develop an ISTEP program testing schedule in
14 which:
15 (1) each student in grades 3, 6, 8, and 10 must be tested; ~~and each~~
16 ~~student must take a graduation examination. and~~
17 **(2) a student who does not meet the educational proficiency**
18 **standard tested in the grade 10 examination may retake the grade**
19 **10 examination in any school year with the consent of the student's**
20 **parent.**
21 (b) A student who is a child with a disability (as defined in IC
22 20-1-6-1) shall be tested under this chapter with appropriate
23 accommodations in testing materials and procedures unless the
24 individuals who develop the child's individualized education program
25 determine that testing under this chapter, or a part of the testing, is not
26 appropriate for the student and that an alternate assessment will be
27 used to test the student's achievement.
28 (c) Any decision with regard to a student who is a child with a
29 disability (as defined in IC 20-1-6-1) to participate in testing under this
30 chapter, to receive accommodations in testing materials and ~~procedure,~~

1 **procedures**, to participate in remediation under IC 20-10.1-17, or to be
2 retained at the same grade level for consecutive school years shall be
3 made in accordance with the child's individualized education program,
4 subject to the ISTEP program manual, and federal law".

5 SECTION 3. IC 20-10.1-16-15 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA
6 CODE AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS
7 [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1999]: Sec. 15. (a) **As used in this section,**
8 **"diploma" means a certificate of graduation that a governing body**
9 **issues to a student to certify that the student has satisfied the**
10 **minimum requirements for high school graduation.**

11 (b) **As used in this section, "diploma seal" means an**
12 **appropriate indicator that is imprinted, impressed, or otherwise**
13 **affixed to a student's diploma to certify that the student has**
14 **satisfied the minimum requirements for receiving a diploma with**
15 **the indicator.**

16 (c) **A governing body of a school corporation or governing**
17 **authority of a nonpublic school must provide an ISTEP+ diploma**
18 **seal to a student who receives:**

- 19 (1) **a diploma; and**
20 (2) **a passing score on the grade 10 examination under the ISTEP**
21 **program".**

22 SECTION 4. THE FOLLOWING ARE REPEALED [EFFECTIVE
23 JULY 1, 1999]: IC 20-10.1-16-1.5; IC 20-10.1-16-13; IC
24 20-10.1-16-14".
