

SENATE MOTION

MR. PRESIDENT:

I move that Engrossed House Bill 1299 be amended to read as follows:

1 Page 1, between lines 6 and 7, begin a new paragraph and insert:
2 "SECTION 2. IC 7.1-3-3-4 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
3 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1999]: Sec. 4. ~~Premises Described~~
4 ~~in Application.~~ **(a)** The premises to be used as a warehouse by an
5 applicant shall be described in the application for the permit. The
6 commission shall not issue a beer wholesaler's permit to an applicant
7 for any other warehouse or premises than that described in the
8 application. The commission shall issue only one (1) beer wholesaler's
9 permit to an applicant, but a permittee may be permitted to transfer his
10 warehouse to another location within the county, upon application to,
11 and approval of, the commission.
12 **(b) As used in this subsection, "immediate relative" means**
13 **father, mother, brother, sister, son, or daughter of a wholesaler**
14 **permittee. Notwithstanding subsection (a), the commission, upon**
15 **the death or legally adjudged mental incapacitation of a wholesaler**
16 **permittee, may allow the transfer of the wholesaler permit only to**
17 **an immediate relative of the wholesaler permittee who**
18 **concurrently holds a majority share in a valid wholesaler permit."**
19 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
