

SENATE MOTION

MR. PRESIDENT:

I move that Senate Bill 96 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Page 2, delete lines 24 through 42.
2 Page 3, delete line 1, begin a new line block indented and insert:
3 **"(5) Not more than a total of six (6) months of credit, as**
4 **determined by the department of correction, for the**
5 **completion of one (1) or more vocational education programs**
6 **approved by the department of correction.**
7 **(6) Not more than a total of six (6) months of credit, as**
8 **determined by the department of correction, for the**
9 **completion of one (1) or more substance abuse programs**
10 **approved by the department of correction.**
11 **However, a person who does not have a substance abuse problem**
12 **that qualifies the person to earn credit in a substance abuse**
13 **program may earn not more than a total of twelve (12) months of**
14 **credit, as determined by the department of correction, for the**
15 **completion of one (1) or more vocational education programs**
16 **approved by the department of correction. If a person earns more**
17 **than six (6) months of credit for the completion of one (1) or more**
18 **vocational education programs, the person is ineligible to earn**
19 **credit for the completion of one (1) or more substance abuse**
20 **programs."**
