

SENATE MOTION

MR. PRESIDENT:

I move that Senate Bill 109 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Page 6, between lines 20 and 21, begin a new paragraph and insert:
2 "SECTION 15. IC 3-7-31-5 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
3 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1999]: Sec. 5. The registration
4 forms prescribed under section 1 of this chapter must:
5 (1) provide for the residence address and the mailing address of
6 the individual completing the forms;
7 (2) contain a statement that a notice of disposition of the person's
8 registration application will be mailed to the mailing address of
9 the individual; and
10 (3) ~~request the~~ **require the applicant to provide the last four (4)**
11 **digits of the applicant's** Social Security number. ~~of the applicant;~~
12 ~~as permitted under the federal Privacy Act of 1974 (5 U.S.C.~~
13 ~~552a).~~
14 SECTION 16. IC 3-7-38.2-10 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
15 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE]: Sec. 10. (a) As provided
16 in 42 U.S.C. 1973gg-6(c)(1)(B)(i), if the county voter registration
17 office determines from information provided under this chapter that a
18 voter has moved to an address different from the address where **the**
19 voter is currently registered, the voter registration office shall:
20 (1) change the registration record to show the new address; and
21 (2) send the voter a notice of the change;
22 **if the information provided under this chapter includes a**
23 **forwarding address.**
24 **(b) If the information provided under this chapter:**
25 **(1) indicates that a voter has moved to an address different**
26 **from the address where the voter is currently registered; and**
27 **(2) does not include a forwarding address;**
28 **the county voter registration office shall indicate on the**
29 **registration record that the voter is an inactive voter at that**
30 **address and shall remove the voter's name from the registration**
31 **rolls under the procedures of this chapter if the voter has not**
32 **voted, has not appeared to vote, or has failed to correct the voter**
33 **registration record within the period described in section 14(2)(B)**

1 **of this chapter.**

2 SECTION 17. IC 3-7-38.2-15 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
3 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE]: Sec. 15. At the
4 expiration of the period ending thirty (30) days after **the second**
5 **general election following** the date on which notices are mailed to a
6 voter described in section 14(2) of this chapter, the county voter
7 registration office shall cancel the registration of a voter who has not
8 responded to the notice sent under section 13 of this chapter.

9 SECTION 18. IC 3-7-38.2-16 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
10 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE]: Sec. 16. The NVRA
11 official ~~may also~~ **shall** conduct ~~an annual~~ a residency confirmation and
12 outreach ~~procedure~~ **program** under this chapter **at least once before**
13 **each general election.** The NVRA official (or a contractor acting on
14 behalf of the NVRA official) ~~may~~ **shall** send a mailing by U.S. mail,
15 postage prepaid, to each voter in Indiana. ~~who has not received a~~
16 ~~mailing under any other provision of this chapter.~~

17 SECTION 19. IC 3-7-38.2-17 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
18 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE]: Sec. 17. (a) The mailing
19 sent under section 16 of this chapter must inquire whether the voter
20 still resides at the residence address indicated on the person's voter
21 registration. If the postcard is returned as undeliverable and the voter
22 does not vote in either of the two (2) general elections following the
23 mailing of the postcard, the county voter registration office shall
24 remove the voter's name from the list of registered voters **at the**
25 **expiration of the period ending thirty (30) days after the second**
26 **general election following the date on which notices are mailed to**
27 **a voter under section 16 of this chapter.**

28 (b) The mailing sent under section 16 of this chapter must also
29 include a copy of the registration form described in IC 3-7-31-5
30 with instructions that the voter may voluntarily update the form by
31 supplying the information required on the form, including the last
32 four digits of the voter's Social Security number. A return
33 envelope, postage prepaid, must be provided with the form for the
34 voter's use in returning the form."
