

SENATE MOTION

MR. PRESIDENT:

I move that Senate Bill 307 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Page 9, between lines 14 and 15, begin a new paragraph and insert:
2 "SECTION 8. IC 12-10-6-6 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
3 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 1998 (RETROACTIVE)]:
4 Sec. 6. (a) To obtain assistance under this chapter, an ~~eligible~~
5 individual must apply to the local administrative unit designated by the
6 division. The application must be:
7 (1) in writing or reduced to writing;
8 (2) made in the manner and upon the form prescribed by the
9 division; and
10 (3) verified by the oath of the applicant.
11 (b) If an individual applying for assistance is mentally or physically
12 unable to sign an application verified by the oath of the applicant, an
13 application may be made by an interested individual acting in the
14 applicant's behalf, and the application shall be verified upon the basis
15 of information and belief of the interested individual.
16 (c) Each application must contain a statement of all of the following:
17 (1) The amount of property, both personal and real, in which the
18 applicant has an interest.
19 (2) All income that the applicant has at the time of the filing of
20 the application.
21 (3) Any other information prescribed by the division."
22 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
