

# SENATE MOTION

**MR. PRESIDENT:**

**I move** that Engrossed House Bill 1458 be amended to read as follows:

- 1           Page 3, between lines 13 and 14, begin a new paragraph  
2           and insert:  
3           "SECTION 5. IC 6-9-19-2 IS AMENDED TO READ AS  
4           FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1999]: Sec. 2. As used in  
5           this chapter:  
6           "Fiscal body" and "executive" have the same meanings that  
7           are prescribed by IC 36-1-2.  
8           "~~Full service hotel or motel~~" means a hotel or motel with  
9           banquet facilities, restaurant, and a lounge in one (1) complex  
10           under common ownership.  
11           "Gross retail income" and "person" have the same meanings  
12           that are prescribed by IC 6-2.5-1.  
13           SECTION 6. IC 6-9-19-5 IS AMENDED TO READ AS  
14           FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1999]: Sec. 5. (a) If a tax is  
15           levied under section 3 of this chapter, the county executive shall  
16           create a commission to promote the development and growth of  
17           the convention and visitor industry in the county.  
18           (b) The commission consists of seven (7) members. The  
19           county executive shall appoint all members to the commission.  
20           Four (4) members must be actively engaged in the management  
21           of a ~~full service~~ hotel or motel in the county. The remainder of  
22           the commission members must be members, officers, or  
23           directors of a chamber of commerce within the county or of  
24           other Indiana not-for-profit corporations organized to promote  
25           and solicit conventions, trade shows, or visitors in the county.  
26           (c) All terms of office of commission members begin on  
27           January 1. Initial appointments must be for staggered terms,  
28           with subsequent appointments for two (2) year terms. A

1 member whose term expires may be reappointed to serve  
2 another term. If a vacancy occurs, the county executive shall  
3 appoint a qualified person, as provided in subsection (b), to  
4 serve for the remainder of the term.

5 (d) A member of the commission may be removed for  
6 cause by the county executive.

7 (e) Members of the commission may not receive a salary.  
8 However, commission members are entitled to reimbursement  
9 for necessary expenses incurred in the performance of their  
10 respective duties.

11 (f) Each commission member, before entering his duties,  
12 shall take an oath of office in the usual form, to be endorsed  
13 upon his certificate of appointment and promptly filed with the  
14 clerk of the circuit court of the county.

15 (g) The commission shall meet after January 1 each year for  
16 the purpose of organization. It shall elect one (1) of its members  
17 president, another vice president, another secretary, and another  
18 treasurer. The members elected to those offices shall perform  
19 the duties pertaining to the offices. The first officers chosen  
20 shall serve from the date of their election until their successors  
21 are elected and qualified. A majority of the commission  
22 constitutes a quorum, and the concurrence of a majority of the  
23 commission is necessary to authorize any action."

24 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
