SENATE BILL No. 62

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning the environment.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 13-11-2-132.5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA
2 CODE AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS
3 [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1999]: **Sec. 132.5. "Municipal solid waste**
4 **landfill"**, for purposes of IC 13-20-7-1, means a solid waste landfill
5 **that meets RCRA Subtitle D design standards as provided for in 40**
6 **CFR Part 258.**

7 SECTION 2. IC 13-20-7-1 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
8 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1999]: Sec. 1. A person may not be
9 required to have solid waste certified as special waste:

- 10 (1) for a single shipment of solid waste if:
11 (†) (A) the solid waste is generated by one (1) generator from
12 one (1) process;
13 (‡) (B) the quantity of solid waste generated by the process is
14 less than one hundred (100) kilograms per month; and
15 (⊕) (C) the quantity of solid waste disposed of is less than one
16 thousand (1,000) kilograms per shipment; **or**
17 (2) **if the solid waste is disposed of at a municipal solid waste**
