SENATE BILL No. 63

DIGEST OF SB 63 (Updated February 25, 1999 5:05 pm - DI 78)

Citations Affected: IC 13-14.

Synopsis: National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit. Specifies that a nonmunicipal discharger is not required to obtain a state permit for the modification or construction of a water pollution treatment facility if the discharger has a NPDES permit or a pretreatment permit for discharges to a publicly owned treatment works.

Effective: Upon passage.

SENATE BILL No. 63

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning environmental law.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

- 1 SECTION 1. IC 13-14-8-11.6 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA
2 CODE AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS:
3 [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE] **Sec. 11.6. A nonmunicipal**
4 **discharger is not required to obtain a state permit for the**
5 **modification or construction of a water pollution treatment or**
6 **control facility if the discharger has:**
7 (1) a **National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System**
8 **(NPDES) permit for direct discharges to surface water; or**
9 (2) a **pretreatment permit for discharges to a publicly owned**
10 **treatment works.**
11 SECTION 2. **An emergency is declared for this act.**
