DIGEST OF SB130 (Updated January 13, 1999 12:28 pm - DI 88)

Citations Affected: IC 25-19.

Synopsis: Board of health facility administrators. Increases from six to eight the number of members of the Indiana state board of health facility administrators who must be present at a meeting to constitute a quorum of the board. Increases from two to three the number of health facility administrator members on the board who must be present to constitute a quorum of the board. (Reflects the change made during the 1998 legislative session increasing the overall membership on the board from 11 to 14.)

Effective: Upon passage.

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SENATE BILL No. 130

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning professions and occupations.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 25-19-1-6 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
2 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE]: Sec. 6. (a) The board
3 shall elect from its membership annually a chairman, vice chairman,
4 and secretary and shall adopt rules to govern its proceedings. Each
5 member of the board who is not a state employee is entitled to the
6 minimum salary per diem provided by IC 4-10-11-2.1(b). Such a
7 member is also entitled to reimbursement for traveling expenses and
8 other expenses actually incurred in connection with the member's
9 duties, as provided in the state travel policies and procedures
10 established by the department of administration and approved by the
11 state budget agency. The health professions bureau shall supply
12 necessary personnel to assist the board in the performance of its duties.
13 (b) ~~Six (6)~~ **Eight (8)** members of the board, including ~~two (2)~~ **three**
14 **(3)** members who are health facility administrators and one (1) member
15 who is an officer of the board, constitute a quorum for consideration of
16 all matters before the board. A majority vote of the quorum is required
17 for action of the board.
