SENATE BILL No. 260

DIGEST OF SB 260 (Updated January 14, 1999 9:27 am - DI 88)

Citations Affected: IC 12-8; noncode.

Synopsis: Family and social services expiration date. Extends the current administrative structure of the office of the secretary of family and social services until July 1, 2002. (Current law provides for the expiration of the administrative structure on July 1, 1999.) Requires the office of the secretary of family and social services to implement methods to facilitate the payment of providers participating in the Medicaid program and to submit a report to the legislative council regarding such methods before July 1, 1999.

Effective: Upon passage; July 1, 1999.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning human services.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

5 AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
6 1, 1999]: **Sec. 14. The office of the secretary of family and social
7 services shall implement methods to facilitate the payment of
8 providers.**

9 SECTION 3. IC 12-8-2-12 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
10 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1999]: Sec. 12. This chapter
11 expires July 1, ~~1999~~: **2002**.

12 SECTION 4. IC 12-8-6-10 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
13 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1999]: Sec. 10. This chapter
14 expires July 1, ~~1999~~: **2002**.

15 SECTION 5. IC 12-8-8-8 IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS
16 [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1999]: Sec. 8. This chapter expires July 1,
17 ~~1999~~: **2002**.

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1 SECTION 6. [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE] **The office of the**
2 **secretary of family and social services, in order to carry out the**
3 **requirement of IC 12-8-1-14, as added by this act, shall:**
4 **(1) determine methods to facilitate the payment of providers**
5 **participating in the Medicaid program; and**
6 **(2) submit a written report of its findings and activities to the**
7 **legislative council before July 1, 1999.**
8 **SECTION 7. An emergency is declared for this act.**
