DIGEST OF SB0458 (Updated February 11, 1999 12:07 pm - DI 100)

Citations Affected: IC 27-1.

Synopsis: Issuance of insurance with auto rentals. Exempts employees of motor vehicle rental companies who negotiate or solicit insurance incidental to a rental agreement from insurance agent's licensure requirements.

Effective: July 1, 1999.

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SENATE BILL No. 458



A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning insurance.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 27-1-15.5-17 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
2 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1999]: Sec. 17. Exemptions. This
3 chapter does not apply to:

- 4 (1) representatives of county farmers mutual insurance
5 companies; or
6 (2) **officers, employees, or representatives of a rental company**
7 **(as defined in IC 24-4-9-7) who negotiate or solicit insurance**
8 **incidental to and in connection with the rental of a motor**
9 **vehicle.**
