

**CONFERENCE COMMITTEE REPORT  
DIGEST FOR SB 165**

**Citations Affected:** IC 35-47-4.

**Synopsis:** Serious violent felons and firearms. Makes possession of a firearm by a serious violent felon a Class B felony. Repeals the current law concerning the possession of certain firearms by a person convicted of a felony. (This conference committee report removes amendments made to the bill in the House of Representatives.)

**Effective:** July 1, 1999.

# CONFERENCE COMMITTEE REPORT

**MR. PRESIDENT:**

*Your Conference Committee appointed to confer with a like committee from the House upon Engrossed House Amendments to Engrossed Senate Bill No. 165 respectfully reports that said two committees have conferred and agreed as follows to wit:*

that the Senate recede from its dissent from all House amendments and that the Senate now concur in all House amendments to the bill and that the bill be further amended as follows:

- 1 Page 1, delete lines 1 through 16.
- 2 Delete pages 2 through 13.
- 3 Page 14, delete lines 1 through 13.
- 4 Page 14, delete lines 35 through 42, begin a new line block indented
- 5 and insert:
- 6 "(3) reckless homicide not committed by means of a vehicle
- 7 (IC 35-42-1-5);
- 8 (4) battery as a Class B felony (IC 35-42-2-1(a)(4)) or Class C
- 9 felony (IC 35-42-2-1(a)(3));
- 10 (5) aggravated battery (IC 35-42-2-1.5);
- 11 (6) kidnapping (IC 35-42-3-2);
- 12 (7) criminal confinement (IC 35-42-3-3);
- 13 (8) rape (IC 35-42-4-1);
- 14 (9) criminal deviate conduct (IC 35-42-4-2);
- 15 (10) child molesting (IC 35-42-4-3);
- 16 (11) sexual battery as a Class C felony (IC 35-42-4-8);
- 17 (12) robbery (IC 35-42-5-1);
- 18 (13) carjacking (IC 35-42-5-2);
- 19 (14) arson as a Class A felony or Class B felony
- 20 (IC 35-43-1-1(a));
- 21 (15) burglary as a Class A felony or Class B felony
- 22 (IC 35-43-2-1);
- 23 (16) assisting a criminal as a Class C felony (IC 35-44-3-2);
- 24 (17) resisting law enforcement as a Class B felony or Class C
- 25 felony (IC 35-44-3-3);

- 1           (18) escape as a Class B felony or Class C felony (IC  
2           35-44-3-5);  
3           (19) trafficking with an inmate as a Class C felony  
4           (IC 35-44-3-9);  
5           (20) criminal gang intimidation (IC 35-45-9-4);  
6           (21) stalking as a Class B felony or Class C felony  
7           (IC 35-45-10-5);  
8           (22) incest (IC 35-46-1-3);  
9           (23) dealing in cocaine or a narcotic drug (IC 35-48-4-1);  
10          (24) dealing in a schedule I, II, or III controlled substance  
11          (IC 35-48-4-2);  
12          (25) dealing in a schedule IV controlled substance  
13          (IC 35-48-4-3); or  
14          (26) dealing in a schedule V controlled substance  
15          (IC 35-48-4-4)."

16          Page 15, delete lines 1 through 18.

17          Page 15, line 21, delete "Class C felony unless ten (10) years have"  
18          and insert "**Class B felony**".

19          Page 15, delete lines 22 through 25, begin a new paragraph and  
20          insert:

21          "SECTION 2. IC 35-47-4-4 IS REPEALED [EFFECTIVE JULY 1,  
22          1999]."

23          Re-number all SECTIONS consecutively.
