

**CONFERENCE COMMITTEE REPORT
DIGEST FOR SB 203**

Citations Affected: Noncode.

Synopsis: Juvenile and restorative justice study commission. Requests the legislative council to consider establishing a 13 member juvenile and restorative justice study commission. Requires the commission to study issues concerning juvenile law and the concept of restorative justice. Provides that the commission operates under the policies and procedures of the legislative council. (This conference committee report removes provisions that would require that all photographs, x-rays, and medical reports relating to a child abuse or neglect investigation be sent to the law enforcement agency that investigates the alleged child abuse or neglect.)

Effective: July 1, 1999.
