

COMMITTEE REPORT

MR. PRESIDENT:

The Senate Committee on Health and Provider Services, to which was referred Senate Bill No. 153, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the Senate with the recommendation that said bill be **AMENDED** as follows:

- 1 Delete the title and insert the following:
- 2 A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning
- 3 pharmacies.
- 4 Page 2, between lines 11 and 12, begin a new paragraph and insert:
- 5 **"Sec. 4. As used in this chapter, "mail order or Internet based**
- 6 **pharmacy" means a pharmacy that is located in Indiana or is a**
- 7 **nonresident pharmacy (as defined in IC 25-26-17-2) that dispenses**
- 8 **prescription drugs:**
- 9 **(1) through the United States Postal Service or other delivery**
- 10 **services; or**
- 11 **(2) after receiving a request for prescription drugs through**
- 12 **the Internet;**
- 13 **to patients in Indiana."**
- 14 Page 2, line 12, delete "4" and insert "5".
- 15 Page 2, line 13, delete ":" and insert "**a mail order or Internet**
- 16 **based pharmacy"**.
- 17 Page 2, delete lines 14 through 19.
- 18 Page 2, run in lines 13 through 20.

1 Page 2, after line 30, begin a new paragraph and insert:
2 "Sec. 6. A mail order or Internet based pharmacy shall comply
3 with the following:
4 (1) The licensure laws of the state in which the mail order or
5 Internet based pharmacy is domiciled.
6 (2) The generic drug laws of Indiana under IC 16-42-22."
(Reference is to SB 153 as introduced.)

and when so amended that said bill do pass.
