

COMMITTEE REPORT

MR. PRESIDENT:

The Senate Committee on Planning and Economic Development, to which was referred Senate Bill No. 514, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the Senate with the recommendation that said bill be **AMENDED** as follows:

- 1 Page 3, line 22, delete "and four (4)".
- 2 Page 3, line 23, delete "nonvoting".
- 3 Page 3, delete lines 26 through 33.
- 4 Page 3, line 34, delete "(4)" and insert "**(2)**".
- 5 Page 3, line 35, delete "(5)" and insert "**(3)**".
- 6 Page 3, line 36, delete "(6)" and insert "**(4)**".
- 7 Page 3, line 38, delete "(7)" and insert "**(5)**".
- 8 Page 3, line 40, delete "(8)" and insert "**(6)**".
- 9 Page 3, line 42, delete "(9)" and insert "**(7)**".
- 10 Page 4, line 3, delete "(10)" and insert "**(8)**".
- 11 Page 4, line 5, delete "A member of the general assembly appointed
- 12 to the".
- 13 Page 4, delete lines 6 through 10.
- 14 Page 4, line 11, delete "(b)".
- 15 Page 4, run in lines 5 through 11.
- 16 Page 4, line 11, delete "section 5(8) through" and insert "**section**
- 17 **5(6) through 5(8)**".
- 18 Page 4, line 12, delete "5(10)".

1 Page 5, between lines 7 and 8, begin a new paragraph and insert:
2 "**Sec. 13. Not later than September 1, 2000, and September 1 in**
3 **each year thereafter, the board shall submit a written annual**
4 **report to the executive director of the legislative services agency**
5 **for distribution to the members of the legislative council. The**
6 **report must include at least the following information:**
7 **(1) The status of the fund as of June 30 of the immediately**
8 **preceding state fiscal year.**
9 **(2) A description of the activities undertaken by the board,**
10 **peer review panels, and the fund in the immediately preceding**
11 **state fiscal year.**
12 **(3) Other pertinent information related to the results achieved**
13 **through grants made under this chapter."**

(Reference is to SB 514 as introduced.)
