

COMMITTEE REPORT

MR. PRESIDENT:

The Senate Committee on Elections, to which was referred Senate Joint Resolution No. 6, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the Senate with the recommendation that said joint resolution be AMENDED as follows:

1 Delete the title and insert the following:
2 A JOINT RESOLUTION proposing an amendment to the
3 Constitution of the State of Indiana concerning elected officials.
4 Page 1, between lines 4 and 5, begin a new paragraph and insert:
5 "SECTION 2. ARTICLE 6, SECTION 1 OF THE
6 CONSTITUTION OF THE STATE OF INDIANA IS AMENDED TO
7 READ AS FOLLOWS: Section 1. There shall be elected, by the voters
8 of the state, a Secretary, an Auditor and a Treasurer of State, who shall,
9 severally, hold their offices for four years, **beginning January 1 after**
10 **their election.** They shall perform such duties as may be enjoined by

- 1 law; and no person shall be eligible to either of said offices, more than
- 2 eight years in any period of twelve years."
- 3 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
(Reference is to SJR 6 as introduced.)

and when so amended that said Bill do pass.
