A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION urging local governments to consider providing health insurance benefits to retired public safety personnel.

Whereas, in 1997, more than 43 million Americans were uninsured for at least part of the year. One post-election survey indicated that the broadest based fear Americans have regarding health care is that they will become uninsured;

Whereas, local public safety personnel serve their communities at great risk to their life and health; and

Whereas, many local public safety personnel are unable to retire due to the unaffordable cost of health care insurance, Therefore:

Be it resolved by the Senate of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana, the House of Representatives concurring:
