Whereas, Tammy Payton has also developed several award winning web lessons that integrate the Internet into the classroom curriculum, including a lesson called "Abraham Lincoln" which was a grand prize winner in Microsoft's Encarta Teacher Lesson Collection;

Whereas, to help students understand that they live in a global community and to learn the similarities and differences of people from other cultures, Ms. Payton created a global activity entitled "E-Mail Around the World"
