SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION honoring the Westfield High School Girl's Cross-Country Team as the 1998 IHSAA State Champions.

Whereas, on November 7, 1998, the Westfield High School Girl's Cross-Country Team won the 1998 IHSAA State Cross-Country Championship;

Whereas, led by Head Coach Scott Lidskin, the Westfield High School team competed against nineteen other teams and 252 girls in the 18th annual IHSAA State Championship, held at the IU Cross-Country Course in Bloomington;

Whereas, the 1998 Cross-Country Championship is Westfield's first state championship of any sport in the school's history;

Whereas, Westfield is an IHSAA Class 3A school in basketball, but won this Cross-Country Championship in an open competition with all schools participating;

Whereas, seven of the team's fifteen members were honored as being named to the Class 1A-3A All-State team, including team championship leader Whitney Bevins, Kendall Diveley, Brandi Sexton, Beth King, team "Mental
