Whereas, DECA is the Nation's largest business oriented club with over 350,000 high school students in all fifty states, in addition to Canada and Guam;

Whereas, Through a wide range of DECA activities, students are given the opportunity to develop vocational understanding, social awareness, and civic consciousness;

Whereas, One of these opportunities for participation is DECA's competitive event competitions; these are academic competitions that give students the chance to exhibit the marketing competencies acquired in their classroom instruction;

Whereas, Individuals compete in events relating to different marketing careers; these events include test taking, case presentations, role playing, with papers documenting a variety of chapter projects also being included in competition;

Whereas, Indiana DECA has nearly one hundred chapters in Hoosier high schools, with one thousand students participating in the Indiana State Career Development
