SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION to congratulate Joe Fisher, Penn High School junior, for winning the Gold Medal in the Under 17 Division of the National Fencing Championships.

Whereas, by virtue of his discipline, skill and endurance, Joe Fisher won the Gold Medal in the Under 17 Division of the National Fencing Championships held earlier this year in Oakland, California;

Whereas, the sixteen year old Penn High School junior emerged victorious after competing for twelve consecutive hours among one hundred and sixty two competitors and winning twelve single-elimination matches in a row;

Whereas, by his performance, Joe was invited to participate as one of three Americans in his division at the World Games held in Venezuela this past April;

Whereas, Joe's work ethic has translated into success in other areas as well, including school, where Joe is an above-average student and a track team member, competing in the hurdles and the long jump;

Whereas, Joe intends to use his skill and discipline to



make the U.S. Olympic team and compete in one of the future Olympic games; and,

Whereas, Joe Fisher should be congratulated on his special achievement for winning this Gold Medal and recognized for his dedication and commitment to success. Therefore:

Be it resolved by the Senate of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana, the House of Representatives concurring:
