SENATE RESOLUTION

MR. PRESIDENT:

I offer the following resolution and move its adoption:

A SENATE RESOLUTION to honor Laurence L. Leggett upon his selection as a recipient of the 1999 Governor's Arts Award.

Whereas, on April 15, Governor Frank L. O'Bannon will present the 1999 Governor's Arts Awards, given each year as tokens of appreciation to individuals for their valuable work in enriching the lives of Hoosiers through the arts and advancing the arts in Indiana through unique and creative means;

Whereas, Laurence L. Leggett, a 1999 recipient of the Governor's Arts Award, from Indianapolis, Indiana, began his career in music education in 1948 when he was hired by the Indianapolis Public Schools as an instrumental music teacher;

Whereas, in the 1950s, Mr. Leggett pursued his career in jazz music with his combo, "Three Flips and a Flop", which achieved great success on the Indianapolis nightclub scene;

Whereas, in 1954 Mr. Leggett signed a three-year recording contract with Chess Records, went on tour for the label throughout the country;

Whereas, Mr. Leggett later decided to localize his professional career and devote his attention to his family and his career in music education as the general music consultant with the Indianapolis Public Schools until his retirement in 1998;

Whereas, it is fitting that the Indiana State Senate recognize and honor Laurence L. Leggett for his selection as a 1999 recipient of the Governor's Arts Award and for his dedication to the advancement of the arts throughout his professional career.
