*Whereas, Rachel and Richard met while Richard was a patient at Methodist Hospital and Rachel was a student nurse;*

*Whereas, Due to the fact that, at that time, student nurses were not permitted to be married, Rachel and Richard were secretly married in Anderson, Indiana;*

*Whereas, Their honeymoon trip was going to a movie with Richard's mother;*

*Whereas, Rachel and Richard established the Miller Lunch restaurant in Cumberland, Indiana, in 1940, which they owned and operated until 1965;*

*Whereas, In later years, Richard was a state driver's license examiner;*

*Whereas, Rachel became a registered nurse at Community Hospital;*

*Whereas, Rachel and Richard's marriage was blessed by a daughter, Patricia, and a son, Richard;*



*Whereas, Throughout their lives together, Rachel and Richard were sustained by their deep love and devotion for each other and their family, their strong faith, and patriotism;*

*Whereas, Rachel and Richard instilled a strong foundation of love in their children, grandchildren and great-grandchildren; and*
