DIGEST OF HB 1131 (Updated February 16, 2000 6:12 PM - DI 76)

Citations Affected: IC 9-21.

Synopsis: Speed limits near schools. Makes it a Class B infraction (subject to a maximum civil judgment of \$1,000) instead of a Class C infraction (subject to a maximum civil judgment of \$500) for a person to violate a speed limit that is imposed in the immediate vicinity of a school when children are present.

Effective: July 1, 2000.

ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL No. 1131

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning motor vehicles.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

- 1 SECTION 1. IC 9-21-5-13 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
2 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2000]: Sec. 13. (a) **Except as**
3 **provided in subsection (b)**, a person who violates this chapter
4 commits a Class C infraction.
5 (b) **A person who exceeds a speed limit that is:**
6 (1) **established under section 6 of this chapter; and**
7 (2) **imposed only in the immediate vicinity of a school when**
8 **children are present;**
9 **commits a Class B infraction.**
