ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL No. 1311

DIGEST OF HB 1311 (Updated February 23, 2000 10:08 AM - DI 88)

Citations Affected: IC 12-24; IC 16-19; IC 16-28.

Synopsis: Requires Medicaid certified comprehensive care health facilities, state institutions, and special institutions to make available to residents, legal representatives of residents, and other individuals designated by residents certain information regarding staffing levels. Requires the office of Medicaid policy and planning to semiannually prepare reports regarding staffing levels at Medicaid certified comprehensive care health facilities. Requires the state department of health, the division of disability, aging, and rehabilitative services, and the division of mental health to semiannually prepare reports regarding staffing levels at state institutions and special institutions. Requires that a compilation of these reports be distributed to certain entities. Requires Medicaid certified comprehensive care health facilities, state institutions, and special institutions to post notices informing residents, legal representatives of residents, and other individuals designated by residents of the availability of the information and reports. Provides conditions these notices must meet.

ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL No. 1311

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning health.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

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eleven (11) inches wide and seventeen (17) inches long.

(3) Contain the:

(A) business telephone number of the superintendent of the state institution; and

(B) toll free telephone number for filing complaints with the division that is administratively in charge of the state institution.

(4) State that if a resident, the legal representative of the resident, or another individual designated by the resident is unable to obtain the information described in subsection (a) from the individual in charge of each shift, the resident, the legal representative of the resident, or other individual designated by the resident may do any of the following:

(A) Contact the superintendent of the state institution.

(B) File a complaint with the division that is administratively in charge of the state institution by using the division's toll free telephone number.

(d) The director of the:

(1) division of disability, aging, and rehabilitative services; and

(2) division of mental health;

may adopt rules under IC 4-22-2 to carry out this section.

SECTION 2. IC 12-24-1-9 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2000]: **Sec. 9. 35 office of Medicaid policy and planning maintains data.

36 (4) A calculation of the average case-mix-adjusted
37 hours-per-resident-day ratio for each health facility by each
38 classification of nursing personnel and the average
39 hours-per-resident-day ratio for each health facility for all
40 other personnel by category for which the office of Medicaid
41 policy and planning maintains data.
