Synopsis: School treasurers. Allows a school corporation to appoint assistant or deputy treasurers. Provides that the term "treasurer" includes an assistant or a deputy treasurer.

ENGROSSED SENATE BILL No. 162

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning education.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

- 1 SECTION 1. IC 20-5-7-0.5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
2 AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
3 1, 2000]: **Sec. 0.5. As used in this chapter, "treasurer" includes an**
4 **assistant treasurer or a deputy treasurer.**
5 SECTION 2. IC 20-5-7-1 IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS
6 [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2000]: Sec. 1. **(a)** Every public school in the
7 state of Indiana shall have a treasurer for the purpose of this chapter
8 who shall be the superintendent or principal of the particular school or
9 some clerk of the school corporation or member of the faculty
10 appointed by such superintendent or principal, such designation to be
11 made immediately upon the opening of the school term or the vacating
12 of such treasurership. All claims shall be filed and paid in accordance
13 with the terms of section 2 of this chapter, and the power to appoint and
14 engage such school treasurer or clerk is hereby granted to the
15 employing and/or appointing officials of the school.
16 **(b) A school corporation may appoint one (1) or more assistant**
17 **or deputy treasurers.**
