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DIGEST OF SB 224 (Updated February 15, 2000 4:26 PM - DI 87)

**Citations Affected:** IC 20-10.1.

**Synopsis:** Military access to student information. Requires a public high school to provide access to the high school campus and student directory information to official recruiting representatives of the armed forces, the Indiana Air and Army National Guards, and the service academies of the armed forces of the United States. Provides for exceptions. Allows public high schools to charge official recruiting representatives a fee to cover copying and mailing costs.

## ENGROSSED SENATE BILL No. 224

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning education.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:*

1 SECTION 1. IC 20-10.1-29-0.5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA  
2 CODE AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS  
3 [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2000]: **Sec. 0.5. This chapter applies only to**  
4 **public high schools.**

5 SECTION 2. IC 20-10.1-29-2 IS AMENDED TO READ AS  
6 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2000]: Sec. 2. As used in this  
7 chapter, "student directory information" means the student's name, ~~and~~  
8 address, **and telephone number.**

9 SECTION 3. IC 20-10.1-29-3 IS AMENDED TO READ AS  
10 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2000]: Sec. 3. ~~If a high school~~  
11 ~~allows any person to have access to the high school campus or the high~~  
12 ~~school's student directory information to make students aware of~~  
13 ~~educational or occupational options offered by the person; the (a)~~  
14 **Except as provided in subsection (b), a high school shall provide**  
15 **access to the high school campus ~~or and~~ the high school's student**  
16 **directory information ~~on the same basis~~ to official recruiting**  
17 **representatives of:**

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- 1 (1) the armed forces of the United States;  
 2 (2) the Indiana Air National Guard; ~~and~~  
 3 (3) the Indiana Army National Guard; **and**  
 4 **(4) the service academies of the armed forces of the United**  
 5 **States;**

6 for the purpose of informing students of educational and career  
 7 opportunities available in the armed forces of the United States, the  
 8 Indiana Air National Guard, ~~and~~ the Indiana Army National Guard,  
 9 **and the service academies of the armed forces of the United States.**

10 **(b) If:**

- 11 (1) a high school student; or  
 12 (2) the parent, guardian, or custodian of a high school  
 13 student;

14 **submits a signed, written request to a high school at the end of the**  
 15 **student's sophomore year that indicates the student or the parent,**  
 16 **guardian, or custodian of the student does not want the student's**  
 17 **directory information to be provided to official recruiting**  
 18 **representatives under subsection (a), the high school may not**  
 19 **provide access to the student's directory information to an official**  
 20 **recruiting representative. A high school shall notify students and**  
 21 **the parents, guardians, or custodians of students of the provisions**  
 22 **of this subsection.**

23 **(c) A high school may require an official recruiting**  
 24 **representative to pay a fee:**

- 25 (1) for copying and mailing the high school's student directory  
 26 information described under subsection (a); and  
 27 (2) in an amount that is not more than the actual costs  
 28 incurred by the high school.

29 SECTION 4. IC 20-10.1-29-4 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA  
 30 CODE AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS  
 31 [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2000]: **Sec. 4. Information received by an**  
 32 **official recruiting representative under section 3 of this chapter:**

- 33 (1) may be used only to provide information to students  
 34 concerning educational and career opportunities available in  
 35 the armed forces of the United States, the Indiana Air  
 36 National Guard, the Indiana Army National Guard, and the  
 37 service academies of the armed forces of the United States;  
 38 **and**  
 39 (2) may not be released to a person who is not involved in  
 40 recruiting high school students for the armed forces of the  
 41 United States, the Indiana Air National Guard, the Indiana  
 42 Army National Guard, and the service academies of the

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1 **armed forces of the United States.**

Between the enacting clause and line 1, begin a new paragraph and insert:

"SECTION 1. IC 20-10.1-29-0.5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2000]: **Sec. 0.5. This chapter applies only to public high schools.**".

and when so amended that said bill do pass.
