DIGEST OF SB 278 (Updated February 17, 2000 12:20 PM - DI 58)

Citations Affected: Noncode.

Synopsis: Ivy Tech assessment and training services. Allows Ivy Tech to promote economic development by providing certain assessment and training services through 2005. Prohibits the community college policy committee from considering this act in developing the community college system. Prohibits Ivy Tech from using the act in negotiating or developing any aspect of the community college system. Expires the act January 1, 2006.

Effective: Upon passage.

ENGROSSED SENATE BILL No. 278

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning education.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

- 1 SECTION 1. [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE] (a) **Ivy Tech State**
2 **College may offer assessment and training services as described in**
3 **subsection (b).**
4 (b) **Ivy Tech State College shall help promote education and**
5 **economic development by providing assessment and training**
6 **services for the citizens of Indiana that include, but are not limited**
7 **to, the following:**
8 (1) **Determining the skills needed for specific jobs.**
9 (2) **Determining whether particular individuals have the skills**
10 **needed to:**
11 (A) **do specific jobs; or**
12 (B) **qualify for specific skill certifications.**
13 (3) **Developing and delivering training programs designed to**
14 **help individuals:**
15 (A) **acquire the skills needed to do specific jobs;**
16 (B) **obtain specific skill certifications; or**
17 (C) **improve the quality of the individual's work product.**

COMMITTEE REPORT

Mr. Speaker: Your Committee on Ways and Means, to which was referred Senate Bill 278, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the House with the recommendation that said bill be amended as follows:

Page 1, delete lines 1 through 7.

Page 1, line 8, delete "(2) Assessment" begin a new paragraph and insert:

"SECTION 1. [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE] **(a) Ivy Tech State College may offer assessment**".

Page 1, line 10, after "Tech" insert "**State College**".

Page 2, delete lines 7 through 10, begin a new paragraph and insert:

"(c) The community college policy committee shall not consider the provision of assessment and training services by Ivy Tech State College that are authorized by this SECTION in developing a community college system under IC 20-12-75. Ivy Tech State College is not granted any rights by this SECTION with respect to the community college system and it shall not use the provision of assessment and training services authorized by this SECTION in negotiating or developing any aspect of the community college system."

Page 2, line 11, delete "(b)" and insert "**(d)**".

Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
