Summary of Legislation: This bill requires members of the Indianapolis police and fire departments to be residents of Marion County.

Effective Date: January 1, 2001.

Explanation of Local Expenditures: This bill may cause some depletion of Indianapolis police and fire personnel if those living outside of Marion County become no longer qualified to be employed. Temporary savings may occur for vacant positions, offset by the probable increase of overtime compensation for remaining staff. The ultimate fiscal outcome would be based on how the departments and personnel respond to this provision.

Of the 726 fire department personnel employed, 125 (17%) live outside of the county. About 60 (6%) of 1,074 police officers live outside of the county.
