MR. SPEAKER:

I move that House Bill 1024 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Page 23, between lines 6 and 7, begin a new paragraph and insert:
- 2 "SECTION 28. [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE] (a) **As used in**
- 3 **this SECTION, "committee" refers to the census data advisory**
- 4 **committee established by IC 2-5-19-2.**
- 5 (b) **Before January 1, 2001, the committee shall study the**
- 6 **following:**
- 7 (1) **The standardization of municipal election calendars to**
- 8 **conform to county, state, and federal elections, including the**
- 9 **following possibilities:**
- 10 (A) **The elimination of town conventions under IC 3-8-5.**
- 11 (B) **The implementation of primaries for the nomination of**
- 12 **candidates in small town elections.**
- 13 (2) **The elimination of municipal elections in odd-numbered**
- 14 **years so that all municipal elections are held in**
- 15 **even-numbered years with countywide elections.**
- 16 **Before January 1, 2001, the committee shall make**
- 17 **recommendations regarding these subjects to the legislative council**
- 18 **as the committee considers necessary.**
- 19 (c) **This SECTION expires January 1, 2001."**
- 20 **Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.**
