MR. SPEAKER:

I move that House Bill 1312 be amended to read as follows:

1 Page 1, line 1, delete "IC 4-4-9.5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA
2 CODE AS" and insert "IC 4-12-1-14.3, AS ADDED BY P.L.273-1999,
3 SECTION 232, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS
4 [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2000]: Sec. 14.3. (a) There is hereby created
5 the tobacco settlement fund for the purpose of depositing money
6 received by the state from the master settlement agreement with the
7 United States' tobacco product manufacturers. The fund shall be
8 administered by the budget agency. The treasurer of state shall invest
9 the money in the fund not currently needed to meet the obligations of
10 the fund in the same manner as other public money is invested. Interest
11 that accrues from these investments shall be deposited in the fund.
12 Money in the fund at the end of the state fiscal year does not revert to
13 the state general fund.

14 (b) Money in the fund (other than money appropriated by
15 P.L.273-1999 for children's health insurance program (CHIP)
16 assistance and children's health insurance program (CHIP)
17 administration in state fiscal years 1999-2000 and 2000-2001 from
18 funds accruing to the state from the tobacco settlement) is
19 appropriated as follows:

- 20 (1) Two-thirds (2/3) of the money deposited in the fund is
- 21 appropriated annually to the pension stabilization fund
- 22 (IC 21-6.1-2-8).
- 23 (2) One-third (1/3) of the money deposited in the fund is
- 24 appropriated annually to the pension relief fund

- 2 Page 1, delete lines 2 through 17.
- 3 Delete pages 2 through 4.
- 4 Page 5, delete lines 1 through 9.
- 5 Page 5, delete lines 40 through 42.

- 7 Page 12, delete lines 1 through 40.
- 8 Page 20, delete lines 10 through 42.

- 10 Page 22, delete lines 1 through 16.
- 11 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
