HOUSE MOTION _____

MR. SPEAKER:

I move that House Bill 1097 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Page 1, between the enacting clause and line 1, begin a new
- 2 paragraph and insert:
- 3 "SECTION 1. IC 9-21-8-35, AS AMENDED BY P.L.18-1999,
- 4 SECTION 1, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
- 5 JULY 1, 2000]: Sec. 35. (a) Upon the immediate approach of an
- 6 authorized emergency vehicle, when the person who drives the
- 7 authorized emergency vehicle is giving audible signal by siren or
- 8 displaying alternately flashing red, **orange**, red and white, or red and
- 9 blue lights, a person who drives another vehicle shall do the following
- 10 unless otherwise directed by a law enforcement officer:
- 11 (1) Yield the right-of-way.
- 12 (2) Immediately drive to a position parallel to and as close as
- 13 possible to the right-hand edge or curb of the highway clear of
- 14 any intersection.
- 15 (3) Stop and remain in the position until the authorized
- 16 emergency vehicle has passed.
- 17 (b) Upon approaching a stationary authorized emergency vehicle,
- 18 when the authorized emergency vehicle is giving a signal by displaying
- 19 alternately flashing red, red and white, or red and blue lights, a person
- 20 who drives an approaching vehicle shall:
- 21 (1) proceeding with due caution, yield the right-of-way by
- 22 making a lane change into a lane not adjacent to that of the
- 23 authorized emergency vehicle, if possible with due regard to
- 24 safety and traffic conditions, if on a highway having at least four
- 25 (4) lanes with not less than two (2) lanes proceeding in the same
- 26 direction as the approaching vehicle; or
- 27 (2) proceeding with due caution, reduce the speed of the vehicle,

1 maintaining a safe speed for road conditions, if changing lanes
2 would be impossible or unsafe.
3 (c) This section does not operate to relieve the person who drives
4 an authorized emergency vehicle from the duty to operate the vehicle
5 with due regard for the safety of all persons using the highway."
6 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
