- 14 CODE AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS
- 15 [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE]: **Sec. 56. (a) This section applies to**
- 16 **an individual who has been diagnosed as having any of the**
- 17 **following dangerous communicable diseases:**
- 18 (1) **Acquired immune deficiency syndrome (AIDS).**
- 19 (2) **Human immunodeficiency virus (HIV).**
- 20 (b) **The corporation may not require an individual described**
- 21 **in subsection (a) to disclose the individual's Social Security**
- 22 **number.**
- 23 SECTION 10. IC 16-41-8-1.5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA
- 24 CODE AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS
- 25 [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE]: **Sec. 1.5. (a) This section applies**
- 26 **to an individual who has been diagnosed as having any of the**
- 27 **following dangerous communicable diseases:**

1 **(1) Acquired immune deficiency syndrome (AIDS).**
2 **(2) Human immunodeficiency virus (HIV).**
3 **(b) The state department may not require an individual**
4 **described in subsection (a) to disclose the individual's Social**
5 **Security number.**
6 **SECTION 11. An emergency is declared for this act."**
7 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
