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## HOUSE BILL No. 1030

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DIGEST OF HB 1030 (Updated January 24, 2000 2:53 PM - DI 87)

**Citations Affected:** IC 5-2.

**Synopsis:** Northwest Indiana law enforcement training center. Removes the July 1, 2000, expiration date from a provision that allows the northwest Indiana law enforcement training center to provide basic training to a law enforcement officer who meets certain requirements. Requires the law enforcement training board to arrange for the use of the Wayne Township Fire Training Center of Marion County for programs provided by the board to the extent feasible.

## HOUSE BILL No. 1030

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A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning state and local administration.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:*

- 1 SECTION 1. IC 5-2-1-15.2 IS AMENDED TO READ AS  
2 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2000]: Sec. 15.2. ~~(a)~~ The northwest

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1 establishes. **In order to encourage firefighter training, the board**

**In order to encourage firefighter training, the board shall arrange for the utilization of the Wayne Township Fire Training Center of Marion County to the extent feasible."**

Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
