DIGEST OF HB 1097 (Updated January 25, 2000 5:41 PM - DI 96)

Citations Affected: IC 9-24.

Synopsis: Address on BMV application. Requires an applicant for a driver's license or permit or state identification card to enter the applicant's mailing address, and if different, the residence address on an application made to the bureau of motor vehicles. Requires the bureau of motor vehicles to maintain records of this information.

Effective: July 1, 2000; January 1, 2001.

HOUSE BILL No. 1097

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning motor vehicles.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

- 1 SECTION 1. IC 9-24-9-2 IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS
2 [EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2001]: Sec. 2. Each application for a
3 license or permit under this chapter must require the following
4 information:
- 5 (1) The name, age, sex, and **mailing address and, if different**
6 **from the mailing address, the residence** address of the
7 applicant. **The applicant shall indicate to the bureau which**
8 **address the license or permit shall contain.**
 - 9 (2) Whether the applicant has been licensed as an operator, a
10 chauffeur, or a public passenger chauffeur or has been the holder
11 of a learner's permit, and if so, when and by what state.
 - 12 (3) Whether the applicant's license or permit has ever been
13 suspended or revoked, and if so, the date of and the reason for the
14 suspension or revocation.
 - 15 (4) Whether the applicant has been convicted of a crime
16 punishable as a felony under Indiana motor vehicle law or any
17 other felony in the commission of which a motor vehicle was

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1 used.

2 (5) Whether the applicant has a physical or mental disability, and
3 if so, the nature of the disability and other information the bureau
4 directs.

5 **The bureau shall maintain records of the information provided**
6 **under subdivisions (1) through (5).**

7 SECTION 2. IC 9-24-11-5 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
8 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2001]: Sec. 5. (a) A permit or
9 license issued under this chapter must bear the distinguishing number
10 assigned to the permittee or licensee and must contain:

11 (1) the name;

12 (2) the age;

13 (3) the **mailing address or residence** address;

14 (4) a brief description; and

15 (5) except as provided in subsection (c), a photograph of the
16 permittee or licensee for the purpose of identification;

17 and additional information that the bureau considers necessary,
18 including a space for the signature of the permittee or licensee.

19 (b) In carrying out this section, the bureau shall obtain the
20 equipment necessary to provide the photographs for permits and
21 licenses as provided in subsection (a).

22 (c) The following permits or licenses do not require a photograph:

23 (1) Learner's permit issued under IC 9-24-7.

24 (2) Temporary motorcycle learner's permit issued under
25 IC 9-24-8.

26 (3) Motorcycle learner's permit issued under IC 9-24-8.

27 (4) Operator's license reissued under IC 9-24-12-6.

28 (d) The bureau may provide for the omission of a photograph from
29 any other license or permit if there is good cause for the omission.

30 SECTION 3. IC 9-24-13-4 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
31 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2001]: Sec. 4. If:

32 (1) an individual holding a license or permit issued under this
33 article ~~moves from~~ **changes** the address ~~where the licensee or~~
34 ~~permittee resided at the time shown on~~ the license or permit
35 **application; was granted to the licensee or permittee; or**

36 (2) the name of a licensee or permittee is changed by marriage or
37 otherwise;

38 the licensee or permittee shall immediately notify the bureau in writing
39 of the licensee's or permittee's old and new address or of the former
40 name and new name and the number of the license or permit held by
41 the licensee or permittee.

42 SECTION 4. IC 9-24-14-3 IS AMENDED TO READ AS



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1 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2001]: Sec. 3. If a licensee or
2 permittee who changes **mailing address or residence** address or name,
3 by marriage or otherwise, desires to have a replacement license or
4 permit indicating the new address or name of the licensee or permittee,
5 the licensee or permittee may request the issuance of the replacement
6 license or permit upon proper application and the payment of the
7 required fee as authorized by this article.

8 SECTION 5. IC 9-24-16-2 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
9 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2001]: Sec. 2. An application
10 for an identification card issued under this chapter must meet the
11 following conditions:

12 (1) Made upon an approved form provided by the bureau, **which**
13 **shall include the mailing address, and if different from the**
14 **mailing address, the residence address of the applicant.**

15 (2) Verified by the applicant before a person authorized to
16 administer oaths and affirmations.

17 SECTION 6. IC 9-24-16-3 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
18 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2001]: Sec. 3. (a) An
19 identification card must have the same dimensions and shape as a
20 driver's license, but the card must have markings sufficient to
21 distinguish the card from a driver's license.

22 (b) The front side of an identification card must contain the
23 following information about the individual to whom the card is being
24 issued:

25 (1) Full legal name.

26 (2) **Mailing address and, if different from the mailing address,**
27 **the residence** address.

28 (3) Birth date.

29 (4) Date of issue and date of expiration.

30 (5) Distinctive identification number or Social Security account
31 number, whichever is requested by the individual.

32 (6) Sex.

33 (7) Weight.

34 (8) Height.

35 (9) Color of eyes and hair.

36 (10) Signature of the individual identified.

37 (11) Whether the individual is blind (as defined in
38 IC 12-7-2-21(1)).

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COMMITTEE REPORT

Mr. Speaker: Your Committee on Roads and Transportation, to which was referred House Bill 1097, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the House with the recommendation that said bill be amended as follows:

Replace the effective dates in SECTIONS 1 through 5 with [EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2001].

Page 1, line 4, delete "or" and insert "**and, if different from the mailing address, the**".

Page 1, line 5, after "applicant." insert "**The applicant shall indicate to the bureau which address the license or permit shall contain.**".

Page 2, between lines 1 and 2, begin a new sentence blocked left and insert: "**The bureau shall maintain records of the information provided under subdivisions (1) through (5).**".

Page 2, line 29, delete ";" and insert "**application;**".

Page 3, between lines 2 and 3, begin a new paragraph and insert:

"SECTION 5. IC 9-24-16-2 IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2001]: Sec. 2. An application for an identification card issued under this chapter must meet the following conditions:

(1) Made upon an approved form provided by the bureau, **which shall include the mailing address, and if different from the mailing address, the residence address of the applicant.**

(2) Verified by the applicant before a person authorized to administer oaths and affirmations."

Page 3, line 12, delete "or" and insert "**and, if different from the mailing address, the**".

Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
