HOUSE BILL No. 1228

DIGEST OF HB 1228 (Updated January 19, 2000 11:01 AM - DI 94)

Citations Affected: IC 36-4.

Synopsis: Consensual annexations. Provides that if an annexation is with the consent of all property owners within the area to be annexed, notice of the public hearing on the annexation must be: (1) published one time at least ten days before the hearing; and (2) given to the property owners within the area to be annexed not later than ten days before the hearing. (Current law provides that notice by publication and by certified mail must be at least 60 days before the hearing.)

Effective: July 1, 2000.

HOUSE BILL No. 1228

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning local government.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

- 1 SECTION 1. IC 36-4-3-2.1, AS AMENDED BY P.L.248-1999,
2 SECTION 1, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
3 JULY 1, 2000]: Sec. 2.1. (a) A municipality may adopt an ordinance
4 under this chapter only after the legislative body has held a public
5 hearing concerning the proposed annexation. The municipality shall
6 hold the public hearing not earlier than sixty (60) days after the date the
7 ordinance is introduced. All interested parties must have the
8 opportunity to testify as to the proposed annexation. **Except as**
9 **provided in subsection (c)**, notice of the hearing shall be:
10 (1) published in accordance with IC 5-3-1 except that the notice
11 shall be published at least sixty (60) days before the hearing; and
12 (2) mailed as set forth in section 2.2 of this chapter, if section 2.2
13 of this chapter applies to the annexation.
14 (b) A municipality may adopt an ordinance under this chapter not
15 earlier than thirty (30) days or not later than sixty (60) days after the
16 legislative body has held the public hearing under subsection (a).
17 (c) **This subsection applies to an annexation under section 3 or**

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1 **4 of this chapter in which all property owners within the area to be**
 2 **annexed consent to the annexation. Notice of the hearing shall be:**

3 **(1) published one (1) time at least ten (10) days before the**
 4 **hearing in accordance with IC 5-3-1; and**

5 **(2) mailed as set forth in section 2.2 of this chapter.**

6 SECTION 2. IC 36-4-3-2.2, AS ADDED BY P.L.217-1999,
 7 SECTION 2, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
 8 JULY 1, 2000]: Sec. 2.2. (a) This section does not apply to an
 9 annexation under section 4(a)(2), 4(a)(3), 4(b), 4(h), or 4.1 of this
 10 chapter.

11 (b) Before a municipality may annex territory, the municipality shall
 12 provide written notice of the hearing required under section 2.1 of this
 13 chapter. **Except as provided in subsection (e)**, the notice must be sent
 14 by certified mail at least sixty (60) days before the date of the hearing
 15 to each owner of real property, as shown on the county auditor's current
 16 tax list, whose real property is located within the territory proposed to
 17 be annexed.

18 (c) The notice required by this section must include the following:

19 (1) A legal description of the real property proposed to be
 20 annexed.

21 (2) The date, time, location, and subject of the hearing.

22 (3) A map showing the current municipal boundaries and the
 23 proposed municipal boundaries.

24 (4) Current zoning classifications for the area proposed to be
 25 annexed and any proposed zoning changes for the area proposed
 26 to be annexed.

27 (5) A detailed summary of the fiscal plan described in section 13
 28 of this chapter.

29 (6) The location where the public may inspect and copy the fiscal
 30 plan.

31 (7) A statement that the municipality will provide a copy of the
 32 fiscal plan after the fiscal plan is adopted immediately to any
 33 landowner in the annexed territory who requests a copy.

34 (8) The name and telephone number of a representative of the
 35 municipality who may be contacted for further information.

36 (d) If the municipality complies with this section, the notice is not
 37 invalidated if the owner does not receive the notice.

38 **(e) This subsection applies to an annexation under section 3 or**
 39 **4 of this chapter in which all property owners within the area to be**
 40 **annexed consent to the annexation. The written notice described in**
 41 **this section must be sent by certified mail not later than ten (10)**
 42 **days before the date of the hearing to each owner of real property,**



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1 as shown on the county auditor's current tax list, whose real
2 property is located within the territory proposed to be annexed.
