HOUSE BILL No. 1230



A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning public libraries.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 4-23-7.1-41 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
 2 AS A **NEW SECTION** TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
 3 1, 2000]: **Sec. 41. (a) As used in this section, "Carnegie library
 4 building" refers to a building:**
 5 (1) **originally constructed for use as a public library with
 6 money donated by Andrew Carnegie; and**
 7 (2) **currently used for public library purposes.**
 8 **(b) As used in this section, "fund" refers to the Carnegie library
 9 building improvement fund established under subsection (c).**
 10 **(c) The Carnegie library building improvement matching grant
 11 program and fund is established for the purpose of providing
 12 matching grants to public libraries to restore and repair Carnegie
 13 library buildings. The state library shall:**
 14 (1) **provide details for the matching grant program, including
 15 eligibility and match requirements; and**
 16 (2) **administer the fund.**
 17 **(d) The fund consists of the following:**

- 1 **(1) Appropriations by the general assembly.**
- 2 **(2) Grants and gifts that the state library receives for the fund**
- 3 **under terms, obligations, and liabilities that the state library**
- 4 **considers appropriate.**
- 5 **(e) The expenses of administering the fund shall be paid from**
- 6 **money in the fund.**
- 7 **(f) The treasurer of state shall invest the money in the fund that**
- 8 **is not currently needed to meet the obligations of the fund in the**
- 9 **same manner as other public funds may be invested. The treasurer**
- 10 **of state shall deposit in the fund the interest that accrues from the**
- 11 **investment of the fund.**
- 12 **(g) Money in the fund at the end of a state fiscal year does not**
- 13 **revert to the state general fund.**
