DIGEST OF HB 1268 (Updated January 25, 2000 11:04 AM - DI 73)

Citations Affected: IC 6-2.5.

Synopsis: Tax exemptions for fuel efficient vehicles. Exempts from the state sales tax any passenger motor vehicles and trucks that have a city fuel economy level of at least 70 miles per gallon. Provides that the exemption expires July 1, 2002.

Effective: July 1, 2000.

HOUSE BILL No. 1268

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning taxation.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 6-2.5-5-39 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
2 AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
3 1, 2000]: **Sec. 39. (a) Sales of:**
4 (1) **passenger motor vehicles (as defined in IC 9-13-2-123);**
5 **and**
6 (2) **trucks (as defined in IC 9-13-2-188) that have a declared**
7 **gross weight of not more than eleven thousand (11,000)**
8 **pounds;**
9 **that have a fuel economy level of at least seventy (70) miles per**
10 **gallon (city), as reported in the Fuel Economy Guide of the United**
11 **States Environmental Protection Agency and the United States**
12 **Department of Energy, are exempt from the state gross retail tax.**
13 (b) **This section expires July 1, 2002.**
