Synopsis: Use of fingerprint records. Allows a local law enforcement agency to use fingerprints submitted for the purpose of identification in a request related to the issuance, reinstatement, or renewal of a license issued by a governmental entity.

HOUSE BILL No. 1297

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning state and local administration.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 5-2-5-14 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
2 AS A **NEW SECTION** TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
3 1, 2000]: **Sec. 14. Pursuant to Public Law 92-544 (86 Stat. 1115), a**
4 **local law enforcement agency may use fingerprints submitted for**
5 **the purpose of identification in a request related to:**
6 **(1) a taxicab driver's license application;**
7 **(2) an application for license for massage therapist; or**
8 **(3) issuance, reinstatement, or renewal of another license**
9 **issued by a governmental entity;**
10 **upon the submission of the applicant's fingerprints and federally**
11 **required search fee.**
