*Whereas, In 1986, Sue Hays Talbot accepted Governor Robert D. Orr's appointment as his Special Assistant for Education and contributed to the creation and implementation of the A+ Program for Education Excellence.*

*Whereas, Sue Hays Talbot provided excellent service as the Assistant for State Relations, having the primary responsibility of working with the Indiana General Assembly on behalf of Indiana University. In 1991, Sue Hays Talbot became the first director of Hoosiers for Higher Education, a grassroots volunteer organization formed to influence funding for Indiana University and higher education in Indiana.*

*Whereas, Sue Hays Talbot serves as Special Assistant for External Relations, as a liaison between the Bloomington community and Indiana University. She also speaks at a variety of education and political seminars and serves on many boards in the community such as Girl's Inc.; Salvation Army; Bloomington Chamber of Commerce; Bloomington Rotary; and the Supervisory Committee of the Indiana University Credit Union.*
