A HOUSE RESOLUTION to congratulate Boy Scout Troop 908 of Chesterton, Indiana for its fiftieth anniversary celebration.

Whereas, On March 11, 2000, Boy Scout Troop 908 of Chesterton will celebrate its fiftieth anniversary with a reception and dinner;

Whereas, In fifty years over 620 boys have participated in summer camp, backpacking, Jamborees, and Philmont;

Whereas, Over 500 families have supported the efforts of Troop 908;

Whereas, Over 260 adults have volunteered their valuable time in leadership and committee roles;

Whereas, Troop 908 has three chartered representatives, the First United Methodist Church, the Chesterton Lions Club , and St. John's United Church;



Whereas, Twelve percent (12%) of the Troop 908 boys, a total of seventy-four (74), have advanced to become Eagle Scouts, six times the national average; and

Whereas, Boy Scout Troop 908 of Chesterton, Indiana exemplifies the finest efforts of a community organization working with the youth of Indiana; Therefore,

Be it resolved by the House of Representatives of the
