A RESOLUTION congratulating the Fort Wayne Bishop Luers High School football team, Fort Wayne, Indiana, on winning the 1999 IHSAA Class 2A state football championship.

Whereas, On November 27, 1999, in the RCA Dome in Indianapolis, Indiana, the Fort Wayne Bishop Luers High School football team became the 1999 IHSAA Class 2A state football champions;

Whereas, The Fort Wayne Bishop Luers Knights claimed the victory over Danville High School, Danville, Indiana, by a score of 38 - 6;

Whereas, The Knights ended their championship season

with a record of 12 - 2;

Whereas, It was the fourth state championship for sixth-ranked Fort Wayne Bishop Luers, which won state titles in 1985, 1989, and 1992;

Whereas, It was the third state championship for the Knights under coach Matt Lindsay;

Whereas, The Knights averaged 24.8 points per game and outscored their opponents by 15.8 points per game; and
