A HOUSE RESOLUTION to congratulate Michael Stoller for winning two events at the State Boys Swimming and Diving Finals.

Whereas, On February 26, 2000, Michael Stoller of Bremen, Indiana won the State Swimming Championship for the 100 Meter Freestyle and the 50 Meter Freestyle;

Whereas, Mike Stoller, a junior at Bremen High School, won the 100 meter freestyle and the 50 meter freestyle, setting a new state record of 20.46 seconds in the latter event;

Whereas, Mike, the son of John and Bonnie Stoller of Bremen, is ninth in his class of 112;

Whereas, He has been on the swimming team for three years, having been a nine time sectional champion for individual and relay team events, the MVP his freshman and sophomore years, the State runner-up in the 50 meter event in 1999, and team captain for one year;



Whereas, Mike Stoller is active in the Ski Club, “B” Club, Pep Club, has acted as a tutor for his fellow high school students, played football for three years, and baseball for one year; and
