Whereas, the Key Learning Community is an option program of the Indianapolis Public Schools, offering a unique educational opportunity for students in kindergarten through high school;

Whereas, the Key Learning Community is located in downtown Indianapolis and draws from the rich resources of its urban environment;

Whereas, in the year 2000, the students and faculty of the Key Learning Community chose to celebrate the concept of Peace. The entire school community was involved in studying the meaning of Peace, and what is needed to foster and maintain Peace in our community, state and country;

Whereas, the students and faculty of the Key Learning Community took their message to the Rotunda of the Indiana State House on January 27, 2000. The message and plea for Peace was expressed through music, sign language, the
