Whereas, Nina Winkler, a 9-year-old from Clayton, Indiana, is truly a hero;

Whereas, Because of Nina's bravery and quick actions, 30 people are alive today;

Whereas, One Sunday afternoon, Nina and her friend, Vincent McKinney of Noblesville, were playing at the Bar P Ranch in Springville, Indiana, when they noticed "something really glowing";

Whereas, Upon further examination, the children discovered that it was a fire;

Whereas, Rather than running to the nearest exit, Nina's thoughts turned to the safety of the other people in the building;

Whereas, Nina knew that she must alert someone of the danger;

Whereas, Nina's cries for help were heard by adults working in the stable kitchen;

Whereas, Due to the early warning by Nina, there was no loss of human life in this dreadful fire;



Whereas, The Indiana state fire marshal's office will be presenting Nina with a certificate of recognition for her bravery and quick action; and

Whereas, Actions such as these merit special recognition: Therefore,

Be it resolved by the House of Representatives of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana, the Senate concurring:
