

SENATE BILL No. 196

DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 31-14-11-1.1.

Synopsis: Temporary support orders in paternity cases. Specifies that a court may enter a temporary order for child support in a paternity action against either or both parents. Provides that a party must make a motion for a temporary order for child support. Requires the clerk of the circuit court to hold in escrow any money paid under a temporary order for child support until the court makes a determination regarding paternity and directs the clerk regarding distribution of the money.

Effective: July 1, 2000.

SENATE BILL No. 196

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning family law and juvenile law.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

- 1 SECTION 1. IC 31-14-11-1.1 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
2 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2000]: Sec. 1.1. **(a)** In a paternity
3 proceeding, the court shall issue a temporary order for child support
4 **against either or both parents:**
5 **(1) upon the motion of a party; and**
6 **(2) if there is clear and convincing evidence that the man involved**
7 **in the proceeding is the child's biological father.**
8 **(b) The clerk of the circuit court shall hold in escrow any money**
9 **paid under a temporary order for child support issued under this**
10 **section until the court:**
11 **(1) makes a final determination regarding paternity; and**
12 **(2) directs the clerk regarding distribution of the money.**
