DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 15-1.5-3-9.

Synopsis: State fair commission report. Requires the state fair commission to report to the state fair advisory committee at the state fair advisory committee's first meeting each year, instead of before March 1 of each year. (The introduced version of this bill was prepared by the state fair advisory committee.)

Effective: July 1, 2000.
