

# SENATE BILL No. 327

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## DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

**Citations Affected:** IC 8-22-3-4.3.

**Synopsis:** Gary airport authority. Adds the mayor of Hammond and the mayor of East Chicago to the Gary airport authority board.

**Effective:** July 1, 2000.

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# SENATE BILL No. 327



A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning utilities and transportation.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:*

- 1 SECTION 1. IC 8-22-3-4.3 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
- 2 AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
- 3 1, 2000]: **Sec. 4.3. (a) This section applies to the board of an airport**
- 4 **authority established by a city having a population of more than**
- 5 **one hundred ten thousand (110,000) but less than one hundred**
- 6 **twenty thousand (120,000) in a county with a population of more**
- 7 **than four hundred thousand (400,000) but less than seven hundred**
- 8 **thousand (700,000).**
- 9 (b) Notwithstanding section 4 of this chapter, the board of an
- 10 airport authority consists of the following six (6) members:
- 11 (1) Four (4) members appointed by the city executive of a city
- 12 having a population of more than one hundred ten thousand
- 13 (110,000) but less than one hundred twenty thousand
- 14 (120,000) in a county with a population of more than four
- 15 hundred thousand (400,000) but less than seven hundred
- 16 thousand (700,000).
- 17 (2) The mayor or the mayor's designee of a city that has a



1           **population of more than thirty-three thousand eight hundred**  
2           **fifty (33,850) but less than thirty-three thousand nine hundred**  
3           **(33,900) in a county with a population of more than four**  
4           **hundred thousand (400,000) but less than seven hundred**  
5           **thousand (700,000).**  
6           **(3) The mayor or the mayor's designee of a city having a**  
7           **population of more than seventy-five thousand (75,000) but**  
8           **less than ninety thousand (90,000) in a county with a**  
9           **population of more than four hundred thousand (400,000) but**  
10           **less than seven hundred thousand (700,000).**  
11           **(c) Not more than two (2) members appointed under subsection**  
12           **(b)(1) may be members of the same political party.**

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
