Synopsis: Grounds for expulsion or suspension of students. Removes the requirement that an activity must be unlawful before a student may be suspended or expelled for the activity.

HOUSE BILL No. 1016



A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning education.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 20-8.1-5.1-9 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
2 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE]: Sec. 9. In addition to the
3 grounds specified in section 8 of this chapter, a student may be
4 suspended or expelled for engaging in ~~unlawful~~ an activity on or off
5 school grounds if:

- 6 (1) the ~~unlawful~~ activity may reasonably be considered to be an
- 7 interference with school purposes or an educational function; or
- 8 (2) the student's removal is necessary to restore order or protect
- 9 persons on school property;
- 10 including an ~~unlawful~~ activity during weekends, holidays, other school
- 11 breaks, and the summer period when a student may not be attending
- 12 classes or other school functions.

13 SECTION 2. **An emergency is declared for this act.**
