

HOUSE BILL No. 1026

DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 9-18.

Synopsis: Indiana Relay for Life trust license plates. Requires the bureau of motor vehicles to design and issue a special group recognition license plate for the Indiana Relay for Life. Provides that a person who is eligible to register a vehicle may obtain an Indiana Relay for Life trust license plate upon completing an application and paying the appropriate fee.

Effective: January 1, 2002.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning motor vehicles and to make an appropriation.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 9-18-15-1, AS AMENDED BY P.L.1-1999,
 2 SECTION 26, AND AS AMENDED BY P.L.222-1999, SECTION 9,
 3 IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JANUARY
 4 1, 2002]: Sec. 1. (a) A person who is the registered owner or lessee of
 5 a:
 6 (1) passenger motor vehicle;
 7 (2) motorcycle;
 8 (3) recreational vehicle; or
 9 (4) vehicle registered as a truck with a declared gross weight of
 10 not more than:
 11 (A) eleven thousand (11,000) pounds;
 12 (B) nine thousand (9,000) pounds; or
 13 (C) seven thousand (7,000) pounds;
 14 registered with the bureau or who makes an application for an original
 15 registration or renewal registration of a vehicle may apply to the bureau
 16 for a personalized license plate to be affixed to the vehicle for which
 17 registration is sought instead of the regular license plate.

- 41 SECTION 2. IC 9-18-47 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE AS
- 42 A **NEW** CHAPTER TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE

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1 JANUARY 1, 2002]:

2 **Chapter 47. Indiana Relay for Life Trust License Plates**

3 **Sec. 1. The bureau of motor vehicles shall design and issue an**
4 **Indiana Relay for Life trust license plate. The Indiana Relay for**
5 **Life trust license plate shall be designed and issued as a special**
6 **group recognition license plate under IC 9-18-25.**

7 **Sec. 2. After December 31, 2001, a person who is eligible to**
8 **register a vehicle under this title is eligible to receive an Indiana**
9 **Relay for Life trust license plate under this chapter upon doing the**
10 **following:**

11 (1) **Completing an application for an Indiana Relay for Life**
12 **trust license plate.**

13 (2) **Paying the fees under section 3 of this chapter.**

14 **Sec. 3. (a) The fees for an Indiana Relay for Life trust license**
15 **plate are as follows:**

16 (1) **The appropriate fee under IC 9-29-5-38(a).**

17 (2) **An annual fee of twenty-five dollars (\$25).**

18 (b) **The annual fee referred to in subsection (a)(2) shall be**
19 **collected by the bureau.**

20 (c) **The annual fee described in subsection (a)(2) shall be**
21 **deposited in the Indiana Relay for Life trust fund established by**
22 **section 4 of this chapter.**

23 **Sec. 4. (a) The Indiana Relay for Life trust fund is established.**

24 (b) **The treasurer of state shall invest the money in the fund not**
25 **currently needed to meet the obligations of the fund in the same**
26 **manner as other public trust funds are invested. Interest that**
27 **accrues from these investments shall be deposited in the fund.**
28 **Money in the fund is continuously appropriated for the purposes**
29 **of this section.**

30 (c) **The commissioner shall administer the fund. Expenses of**
31 **administering the fund shall be paid from money in the fund.**

32 (d) **On June 30 of each year, the commissioner shall distribute**
33 **the money from the fund to the Relay for Life-American Cancer**
34 **Society, Howard County Unit.**

35 (e) **Money in the fund at the end of a state fiscal year does not**
36 **revert to the state general fund.**

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
